

Media Advisory, Kati Haycock to speak at UCSD

EVENT: Kati Haycock, executive director of the Achievement Council (a nonprofit, statewide consortium formed to improve the K-12 performance of minority students) will speak at UCSD regarding the results of a three-year analysis of achievement patterns in California schools and the roots of underachievement. Kati will discuss these findings and how colleges and universities can help change these patterns when she speaks to a UCSD committee on recruitment, enrollment and retention.
