MEDIA BOARD CHARTER

UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, SAN DIEGO

JUNE 1, 1986

I. NAME

The name of the body established by this charter shall be the Media Board of the University of California, San Diego.

II. FUNCTION OF THE MEDIA BOARD

Under the authority delegated by the Chancellor of this campus to the Associated Students of UCSD, and subscribing to the policies and regulations of the University, the Media Board is hereby established by the Associated Students to provide for the promotion, maintenance and regulation of recognized student communications media at UCSD.

- A. The Media Board shall be the Advisory Board to the UCSD Associated Students on student media organizations.
- B. The Media Board shall provide student media with the access to available facilities and funds as defined in the provisions of this charter.
- C. The Media Board shall act as the charter publisher of recognized student media and provide them assistance in achieving the highest level of participation, utilization and quality possible.
- D. The Media Board shall not engage in the editorial censorship of student communications media.

III. PURPOSE OF STUDENT MEDIA

Student funded media can and should continue to exist as long as students find them useful tools in their educational development. Media funded by student monies and using campus equipment and facilities have the responsibility to present news and material that is also of interest and educational value to the entire university community. (The university community includes the students, faculty and staff; their places of work, student and residence, i.e., the UCSD campus and off-campus facilities and all San Diego County Communities where UCSD people live). The informational needs of students includes that broad range of needs which they share with other people for knowledge which enables them to participate more fully and wisely in the decision making processes of our society.

IV. MEMBERSHIP

- A. Commissioner of Communications:
 - 1. The Commissioner shall act as chairman of the Media Board.
 - 2. The Commissioner shall not vote except in the case of a tie.
- B. Other Voting Members:
 - 1. Each college council shall appoint one member to the Media Board.
 - 2. The ASUCSD Council, in consultation with the Commissioner of Appointments and Evaluations, shall appoint one member.
 - 3. The ASUCSD President shall nominate one member, subject to council approval.
- C. Ex-Officio Members: (all privileges of membership except voting):
 - 1. One representative appointed by the Graduate Student Council.
 - 2. One representative appointed by each registered media.
 - 3. Any advisors and professionals the Board deems necessary to conduct its business.
- D. All appointments shall be made for one calendar year, beginning July 1 of each year.

V. POWERS

A. Recognition

- 1. As required by campus regulations published in the UCSD University Policies and Regulations applying to Campus Activities, Organizations and Students, all student communications media, must register with the Student Organizations Office and the ASUCSD.
- 2. To be eligible for funding, after registering as a student organization, any student media may apply to the Media Board for funding or other support.

B. Funding

1. The Media Board shall prepare an annual budget. That budget shall be submitted to the Associated Student president, to be presented in his budget address to the council. It shall be reviewed by the council and sent to the finance committee. Final approval shall come from the council.

- The Media Board budget shall reflect the individual budget allocations of recognized student media as provided for in the by-laws.
- 3. The Media Board shall be responsible to the A.S. for the financial integrity of all recognized student media.
- 4. No student media may solicit or receive University funds independently without approval of the Media Board and the A.S. Media Board shall solicit funds for all student media.
- 5. The Media Board shall approve all contractual agreements entered into by all registered student media.
- 6. The Media Board, through its delegated representatives, shall be the sole repository for funds allocated to and received for use by all registered student media. Income derived from advertising shall automatically revert to the Media Board sub account for the media to which it was contracted.
- 6a. The Media Board, through its delegated representatives, shall be the sole repository for funds which the media receive in donations, advertising, income, and allocations.
- 6b. Any individual who solicits advertising for a publication may receive a percentage of the income from the ad. This percentage, or "commission", shall not exceed 20% of the income from the ad.

C. Appeals

1. Any media has the right to appeal funding level to the A.S. Council for a review by the Finance Committee. Such an appeal must be initiated by an A.S. Council member through the appropriate legislation.

VI. DEFINITION OF MEDIA

- A. Print media includes, but is not limited to, newspapers, journals, magazines and othe rtypes of periodicals regardless of their frequency of publication.
- B. Electronic media includes, but is not limited to, radio and television broadcast.
- C. Dependent and Independent Media:
 - 1. Dependent media are those media which require financial support in order to carry on broadcast or publication activities.

VII. FINANCIAL RESTRICTIONS

- A. No tabloid publication shall receive funding for more than 72 pages per quarter -- unless that publication can generate extra income to pay for the increased cost of extra paper.
- B. Each tabloid publication will receive funding for only newsprint quality paper -- unless that publication can generate extra income to pay for the increased cost of higher quality paper.
- C. Each publication shall receive funding for one color of ink -- if that publication wishes to pay for the increased cost of additional color, it may do so by generating extra income.

D. Income

- 1. A minimum of \$50.00 will be required per issue in income, which must be used towards the productions costs of the tabloid or journal.
- All projected income may be liened by the ASUCSD towards the production of the paper.
- 3. The ASUCSD reserves the right to lien any income to cover deficits when such are incurred.
- 4. The maximum number of copies per issue shall be set by the Media Board at the Media Board hearings.

VIII. FACILITIES

- A. All facilities located in the Student Center for the purpose of producing print or electronic media shall be under the auspices of the Media Board.
- B. Recognized media shall be entitled to use these facilities, on a equitable basis, with the approval of the Media Board.
- C. Others may use these facilities with the approval of the Media Board.

IX. MEETINGS

- A. Meetings shall be open to all members of the UCSD community; students, faculty, staff and administration, and such meetings must be publicized.
- B. Meetings shall be held at three times per quarter, at the rate of one per month.

- C. Any voting member, or the Commissioner of Communications, may call additional meetings.
- D. A quorum shall consist of any four voting members.
- E. Meetings shall otherwise be conducted according to $\underline{Robert's}$ \underline{Rules} of Parliamentary Procedure.

X. AMENDMENTS

- A. This charter may be amended by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the ASUCSD Council.
- B. This charter may be amended by a majority vote in any A.S. referendum.
 - 1. The ASUCSD Council may place an amendment on any ASUCSD referendum according to the ASUCSD Election Codes.
 - 2. Any undergraduate may place an amendment on any ASUCSD referendum ballot according to the referendum rules in the ASUCSD Election Codes.

XI. BYLAWS

- A. By-laws shall be added to this charter by the Media Board to clarify any portion of the charter.
- B. By-laws shall not alter the charter itself, but shall indicate, in more detail, procedures for carrying out its provisions.

VOLUNTEER CONNECTION AT UCSD (VCUCSD)

CHARTER

DESCRIPTION

The Volunteer Connection at UCSD (VCUCSD) exists as a student organization in coordination with the ASUCSD, the administration, and the entire UCSD Community, to connect undergraduate and graduate students with volunter projects in the San Diego area.

GOAL

The VCUCSD is an ongoing effort to inspire and facilitate a minimum of 350 UCSD volunteers to devote approximately 3 hours per week for a quarter to community work related to poverty and education. The hosts for such volunteers are the San Diego Unified School District and about 30 of the area's non-profit organizations.

POLICY

TIPSY TAXI PROGRAM

<u>PURPOSE</u>: The purpose of the Tipsy Taxi program is: one, to provide students with an alternative to driving under the influence; two, to give an alternative to passengers who feel that the driver is under the influence; three, to give hosts an slternative to letting their guests drive home under the influence; and four, to show that UCSD students believe that drinking and driving is of great concern and must take an active part in reducing this problem.

SPECIFICATIONS:

- 1. This project is limited to only UCSD students. A valid I.D. must be shown in order to use the service.
- 2. Due to certain abuses of the service trial run, a 10 mile radius around the UCSD Campus has been set. A 10 mile radius includes most areas where UCSD students live.
- 3. This sevrice will operate only on Fridays and Saturdays from 5:00 p.m. to 3:00 a.m. every week of the academic year.
- 4. Funding of this programwill be from General Unallocated. For a total expense not to exceed \$5000 for the taxis service, with an additional \$250 to be allocated for the publicity of the event. For a grand total of \$5250.

Publicity for this service is to include a UEO Banner to be used at all TGIF's, Flyers, Posters for all Kiosks, and business cards.

THE UCSD TIPSY TAXI PROGRAM

Purpose and Background

An examination of programs that provide students with a viable alternative to driving under the influence was recently completed. Two programs, those of University of California, Davis and University of San Diego, were very helpful in creating a plan to implement a Tipsy Taxi Service at DCSD. This examination helped answer many questions that arose. The most important question was what type of transportation should be used. A taxi-run service was picked as opposed to a student-run shuttle or other similar programs for a variety of reasons. The first is that there are many liability problems that the ASUCSD and University would be faced with if a student-run shuttle was used, and thus the cost would be too high to implement such a program. And secondly, it is important that the service be easily accessable and reliable for students if the program is going to be successful. Both UCD and USD drew similar conclusions and favored a taxi-run program. Their experience thus far, with a taxi-run program, has been positive.

In creating this program for UCSD, steps were taken to make the service as efficient as possible. In January, a survey was conducted to assess the need and feasibility of such a program. The 706 completed surveys were favorable and provided helpful information for the logistics of the program (see Table I). Next, letters were sent to various taxi companies soliciting their support for the program. Many replies were received and negociations with the taxi companies are currently underway.

The purpose of the Tipsy Taxi Service program is: one, to provide students with an alternative to driving under the influence; two, to give an alternative to passengers who feel that the driver is under the influence; three, to give hosts an alternative to letting their guests drive home under the influence; and four, to show that UCSD students believe that drinking and driving is of great concern and must take an active part in reducing this problem.

Discription of Proposed Program

Students will call the taxi company directly and present a valid UCSD I.D. and the taxi company will bill the ASUCSD directly. A trial run will take place on Friday May 2, Saturday May 3, Friday May 9, and Saturday May 10. That is, the weekend of the Cinco de Mayo celebration and prior to Greek Week, and the weekend of Greek Week and the Sun God Festival. This trial run will enable us to evaluate the program and decide whether or not to start a full program in the Fall.

Operations:

- The Coordinator organizes all media correspondence and publicity.
- 2. The Coordinator continously evaluates the taxi company's performance and verifies all charges.
- 3. The Coordinator handles all special requests for taxi operations from fraternaties, sororities and private parties.
- 4. The Coordinator works with the President of the ASUCSD to ensure the program is being run according to the wishes of the student government. (See Table II).

I. Description

The Sports Activity Board shall exist as a subordinate body of the Associated Students and shall report directly to the Associated Students Council or the Associated Students President.

II. Purpose

The Purpose of the Sports Activity Board is to create programs generating student awareness, support and enthusiasm of UCSD Intercollegiate Athletics.

III. Membership

- A. One member from each college to be appointed by their respective College Council.
- B. One member from the A.S. Council to be elected from within the Council.
- C. One member appointed by the A.S. President.

- B. A quorum shall consist of any four (4) voting members.



INTRODUCTION:


Parking at UCSD poses a serious problem for students. The student often faces two options: arriving at school before 8:00 am, or parking at peripheral lots far away from their classroom buildings.

While there are many long term plans for parking, including the introduction of a parking structure in 1990, the situation on campus is growing rapidly worse. In July of 1987 this problem will be compounded by the elimination of approximately 700 spaces due to the creation of bike lanes along North Torrey Pines Road, La Jolla Village Drive and Torrey Pines Road south of La Jolla Village Drive in July of 1987.

Students are finding the replacement of "S" spaces with "B" spaces and "A" spaces in various lots across campus. Furthermore, the opinions of the student at large are not fully represented within the decision making process.

Action: Creation of an Ad-Hoc Parking Committee of 5 undergraduate students appointed by the A.S. President. The Chairperson of the committee will be responsible to report to the A.S. President, and will attend all Parking Advisory Meetings on behalf of the A.S. All conclusions will be reported to the Parking Office. The committee would be charged with the following responsibilities:

- * Investigate the feasibility of prioritized parking.
- * Work with Parking Office to solicite student opinion.
- * Evaluate the Faculty/Staff/Student parking ratio.
- * Evaluate the feasibility of van/car pooling from areas of high student population.
- * Investigate the use of modes of transportation other than single occupant auto for travel to and from campus.
- * Evaluate the balance between close-in and peripheral parking.
- * Investigate the possible incorporation of bicycle travel to and from peripheral areas.
- * Distribute parking information to students through the bulletin, Alternative Media, Rallies, etc.
- * Investigate on campus transportation possibilities.
- * Evaluate the decision making process by the administration and its consideration of student input.
