UCSD HOSTS PROFESSIONAL/GRADUATE SCHOOL INFORMATION DAYS

College students and community members will have an opportunity to talk to admissions representatives from more than 90 graduate and professional schools at two University of California, San Diego information fairs.

Professional and Graduate School Information Day will be Nov. 2 at the UCSD Career Services Center plaza from 11:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. Recruiters from a broad range of programs, including international affairs, health professions and MBA and academic degree programs, will staff information tables and answer questions.

The events are sponsored by the UCSD Career Services Center, the Office of Graduate Studies and Research and the School of Medicine.

According to Cyndie Morozumi, fair coordinator, a record number of schools indicated an interest in participating in the event. "This year, for the first time, we've had to turn away schools due to space constraints. We're very pleased with the response," Morozumi said.

Each of the University of California campuses will be well represented in a variety of programs, including UC Berkeley's MBA program, the medical schools at both UCSD and UCLA, UC San Francisco's dental school, several academic degree programs, and many more.

Schools from the midwest and east coast, including the University of Michigan's MBA program and Princeton University's Woodrow Wilson School of International Affairs, will also be represented.

The following week, on Nov. 11, UCSD will host some of the nation's top law schools at Pre-Law Day. From 11:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m., at the Career Services Center plaza, admissions representatives from institutions including Stanford, Cornell, UCLA, the University of Southern California and Hastings will be available to provide information and answer questions.
