"INCA," THE PERUVIAN ENSEMBLE, TO PERFORM AT UCSD ON FEB. 9

The unique sounds of Peruvian music will be performed at 8 p.m. Friday, Feb. 9, in the University of California, San Diego Price Center Theatre, by "INCA," the Peruvian Ensemble.

With colorful and authentic costumes, and rare Peruvian instruments such as the zampona and the toyo (pan pipes of various types and sizes), the tarka (a wooden flute), and the bombo (a drum made out of a hollowed-out tree), the group will share the music of Peru and the heritage of the ancient Quechua and Aymara cultures.

"INCA" has received support through grants from the National Endowment for the Arts, the California Arts Council, the California Community Foundation, and many other groups, businesses and corporations in Southern California. With the help of these benefactors, "INCA" has been able to record much of the company's repertoire.
