

Regents approve funds for University House

January 21, 1966

The University of California Board of Regents, meeting on the Santa Barbara campus, Friday approved the appropriation of \$11,900 from the University Fund for the preparation of preliminary plans and working drawings for University House on the San Diego campus.

University House will be the residence of Chancellor and Mrs. John S. Galbraith. The residence will be designed to accommodate the needs of the Chancellor's family, with special additional facilities for entertaining sizable groups of people. It will function as the focal point for the Chancellor's social contacts with students, faculty, and friends and guests of the University.

On Thursday, The Regents approved a recommendation by the Committee on Grounds and Buildings that University House be located about 800 feet east of the Bureau of Commercial Fisheries building and adjacent to the northerly border of the Scripps Institution of Oceanography. The site is adjacent to a faculty residential area and is easily accessible from both the upper and lower reaches of the campus, via La Jolla Shores Drive.

From the site there is a commanding view of the coastal area and the town center of La Jolla as well as ample space for pa2king and related functions. Construction of University House is scheduled during the 1966-67 fiscal year.

The present University House, which is leased by the University for the Chancellor and his family, is located near the campus on Greentree Lane.
