FREE SPECIAL TOURS OF UCSD CAMPUS ARE AVAILABLE

Sunset walking tours every Wednesday are a new addition to the free tours of the University of California, San Diego campus offered by the UCSD Visitors Program.

Beginning June 23, the free 90-minute Wednesday tours will originate at 6 p.m. from the Gilman Information Pavilion.

Continuing to be available are mini-van tours the first and third Sundays of each month, and walking tours offered on alternative Sundays. Both originate at 3 p.m. from the Gilman Information Pavilion.

The tours include some of the Stuart Collection of outdoor sculptures, and do not include building interiors.

Although all tours are free, there is a minimal UCSD parking fee.
