



I agreed, however, adjority of the land camers and the neigh/ournowds were in favour and told me that they want to give most of the land to the administration. The main reason is that they wanted to stay with the Administration more closely in case of tribal fights and such. Consequently, after a long time of discussing with the landowners, everybody firstly agreed that the new Patrol Post must be establish at Nummitera. Then I employed 20 labours to clear and cut the pitpit along the boundary. At 1630 hours we called for the day.
- 19/12/73 3. At 0730 hours, labours we given a roll call and distributed the work right many. One major request in which most land owners concerned about was the payment of the land. I told them that the administration will spend some consider-

- 20/12/73 4. Again, at 0730 hours, I aske the labours to continue on cutting the pitpit. At 0800 hours the Assistant District Commissioner came and took me down to Takusanda to see the location as an Aternative to establish the patrol just. To we gaged through we felt the location and sight of the area didn't suit us. Therefore, it was firmly agreed that mammaitass was the suitable place to set up the patrol post. At 1200 hours, we came back and continued on with the surveying till 1700 hours.

After the completion of the surveying the area appeared to be 300 metres by 264 metres approximately. As the labours finished cutting along the boundary, I asked there to start on the real block which was being surveyed. At 1730 hours we called for the day.

#### SOME OPTHIONS

- 6. My personal chinions towards the new patrol post is quite contrasting with any administration officers. I felt Mammittase is quite a reasonable place to establish the new patrol post for many reasons but I would like to point out the three major ones.
  - 1. It is almost the carties of both wabig and Laisgam for political and administration purposes.
  - 2. It is also the centre of the population and distance from Wabag to Laisgam.
  - 3. The location and the sight itself is suitable to extend a town if possible.
- 7. However, Mamaitasa regardedly is situated over the summit of the Highlands region and as a result it is very cold up there. At the present the new patrol post is under the process of construction.
