

Debate on foundations of Capitalism & Socialism to be held

May 12, 1969

The philosophical foundations of Capitalism and Socialism will be the topic of a debate-discussion between an ardent supporter of each system at 8:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 15, in the Revelle Cafeteria at the University of California, San Diego.

Herman Rumper, a graduate student and teaching assistant at UCSD, will present the philosophical foundations of socialism. Rumper is popular with radical New Left students and is a very articulate spokesman for New Left ideals.

Representing Capitalism will be Tibor Machan, who is working toward his Ph.D. in philosophy at UC Santa Barbara. Machan, a libertarian and student of Objectivism, also does free-lance writing and has published articles such magazines as *The Personalist*, *The Freeman* and *Barron's*.

A question and answer period will provide an opportunity for the audience to question the participants in the debate, which promises to be controversial as well as enlightening.
