JCSanDiego ELEAS

Outstanding Alumnus Awarded to an alumna or alumnus of an undergraduate or graduate program of UC San Diego who has rendered special or outstanding service, or, through personal achievements, brought honor and distinction to the university.

Professional Achievement Awarded to an alumna or alumnus of an undergraduate or graduate program of UC San Diego who has an established record of accomplishments, complemented by significant contributions to a profession.

Distinguished Service Awarded to an alumna or alumnus of an undergraduate or graduate program of UC San Diego whose dedication and volunteer commitment has significantly enriched the university.

Distinguished Teaching Awarded to a UC San Diego faculty member who excels in communication, organization and responsiveness to students and who has a genuine interest in stimulating student growth through learning. A cash award accompanies this recognition.

These prestigious annual alumni awards honoring the best of UC San Diego will be presented on Saturday, June 5, 2010, as part of the Alumni Weekend festivities. Proceeds from the *Awards for Excellence* benefit the UCSD Alumni Association's endowed scholarship programs.
