

Bernard Sisco appointed as an acting assistant to UC President

Bernard Sisco, vice chancellor for administration at the University of California, San Diego, has been appointed as an acting assistant to University of California President David S. Saxon.

Sisco will be implementing a recently completed management information systems report for the University of California system. His appointment will last approximately two years during which time he will maintain an office in University Hall near the Berkeley campus. During his absence from the San Diego campus, H.D. Johnson, vice chancellor for financial management, will coordinate administrative functions.

Prior to his appointment at UC San Diego in 1972, Sisco served as assistant director for administration of the National Science Foundation in Washington, D.C.
