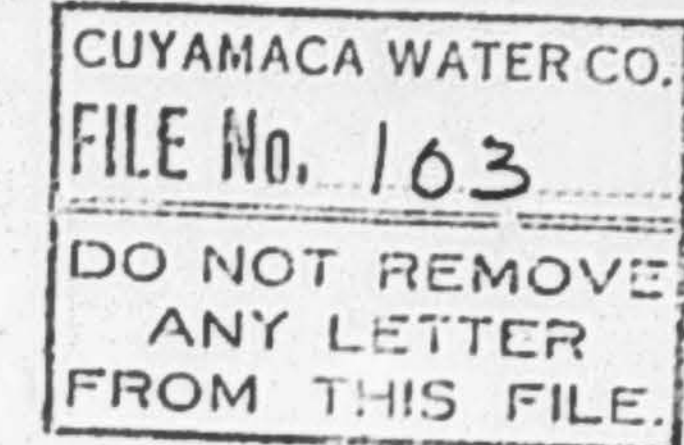
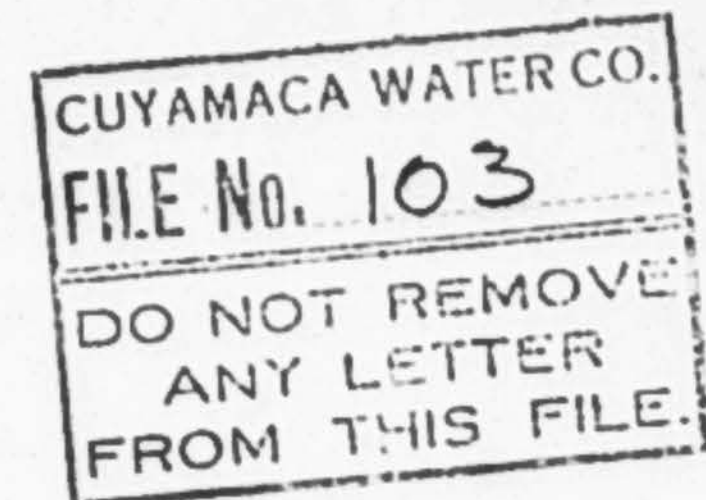
Dear Sir:

This will confirm the conversation and the telegrams between your Company and the writer, relative to the installation of a Liquid Chlorine Sterilization Plant for your Company at La Mesa Reservoir, in San Diego County.

We will provide and install complete, upon your foundations, one Model C-6 Liquid Chlorine apparatus, with a meter capacity of from 0 to 44 oz. per hour, all complete and ready for operation, for the sum of One thousand, two hundred and forty Dollars (\$1,240.00).

It is understood that you are to provide the necessary foundations to receive the apparatus, and properly house same, and that you are to bring up to the top of the apparatus, a minor water supply not less than 3/8" in diameter, for the operation of the apparatus. The apparatus is to be delivered to you in San Diego, and you are to provide transportation from San Diego to the site of its installation. All of the work, including setting up of the apparatus, and placing same in operation, is to be done by us.

It is understood that this equipment is coming to you

by express, and that erection is to be completed at once, upon its delivery to you.

We have also ordered for you, One Model D Chlorine Plant, to be installed at your Eucalyptus Reservoir, on which we beg to quote you a price of Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) installed complete, upon the same conditions as stipulated above for the Model C-6.

Delivery and erection of this apparatus will be made at the same time as that above.

On Liquid Chlorine in Bottles containing 100# each, we beg to quote you the price of Fifteen Cents (15¢) per pound, F.O.B. Cars Niagara Falls, with a charge of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) per bottle, which is returned to you upon the return of the bottles in good condition, F.O.B. Cars Niagara Falls.

We will give you an annual contract for the purchase of Chlorine at this price, protecting you against any further raise, provided you will indicate to us the probable annual maximum and minimum requirements of your plants. We have ordered to come along by express, with the apparatus, 3 cylinders of Chlorine, and have ordered ten extra cylinders to follow at once by freight. The writer expects this apparatus to arrive in San Diego, on Wednesday, March 22nd, and will be prepared to start the installation of same on Wednesday, March 23rd.
