

Cathy Berberian and Leonard Stein to perform

April 4, 1967

Contemporary music by mezzo soprano Cathy Berberian and pianist Leonard Stein will be presented at 8:30 p.m. Tuesday, April 11, in Sherwood Hall, La Jolla. The concert is jointly sponsored by the University of California, San Diego Committee for Arts and Lectures and the UCSD Department of Music.

A remarkable soprano and actress, Miss Berberian's songs cover the music "of our time" from Luciano Berio (Miss Berberian's husband)

and John Cage to the Beatles. The concert Tuesday will include the music of John Cage and Kurt Weill as well as Berio's Sequenzas 3 and 4.

Reviews in both Newsweek Magazine and the New York Times have stated that Miss Berberian's success as a gifted musician and a theatrical personality stems largely from the fact that she projects with unmatched brilliance the image of our own time. Her repertoire now includes more than thirty works written expressly for her unique virtuosity.
