Sir My father directs me to write you as follows. In December last he ordered to be sent to your care a Bale containing the following goods

- 1 ps, $51\frac{3}{4}$ yds. Red flannel
- 3 ,, Prints 103 yards
- 1 ,, $13\frac{1}{2}$ Super fine cotton

At which time he left a letter for my Mother and one for you to be forwarded with the Bale.

My father having been informed by me that my Mother did not receive the goods or letter made enquiry of the merchant who says they were shipped as directed. My father thinks that possibly the letters may have been lost and the package come to your hands without any instructions if so please deliver the Bale to my Mother.

He requests you to write by return Mail, in answer to this.
