TIPS FOR MAKING BETTER RECORDINGS

Record Level-You may record with greater input using "Scotch" High Output-Low Noise Tape. A 3 db increased input level over the tape you have been using results in greater output without added distortion and a correspondingly lower noise level upon playback.

Storage-Extremes of humidity and temperature should be avoided. Best storage conditions are 40% to 60% Relative Humidity at room temperature. When tape has been stored for six months or more, it is good practice to rewind before using.

Cleaning-The recorder heads, guides, capstan and pressure roller should be cleaned periodically with a cotton swab slightly moistened with alcohol or Freon TF* to assure best performance.

Rewinding-The oxide surface of the tape must face the magnetic heads in the recorder. The tape is supplied with the oxide surface wound facing in. *DuPont Trademark.

IMPORTANT: To splice back-treated tapes use "Scotch" Brand No. 621 Splicing Tape.
