Dear Sir:

I have the tract of land at the corner of Cajon Avenue and North Palm in this city, which land is about an acre. On this I have about 1200 chickens, quite a variety of fruit trees, and on this tract I raise all the green stuff for the chickens and have a vegetable garden also. Commencing with last month my water rate was suddenly raised, without matter, and for no reason that I can find out. Many of my neighbors have a less rate than I and do not raise nearly so much on their places, and do not consume as much water as I do.

My former rate was 26g for the first 100 cu ft, 16g for the next 100, and the balance at 7g. With this rate I was satisfied, but now I am deprivedof the 7g water, and I do not feel I can afford to operate the place on this increased rate. Once before several years ago, my rate was raised as now, and upon my taking up the matter with the railroad commission the rates were reduced to the old rate. If that was fair then I think it should apply now.

Kindly let me hear from you what your decision is in this matter.
