THE MUIR STRING QUARTET WILL PERFORM AT UCSD ON APRIL 25

The last ensemble in the 1991-92 UCSD Chamber Music Series, the Muir String Quartet, will perform at 8 p.m. Saturday, April 25, in the Mandeville Auditorium at the University of California, San Diego.

Tickets for this event are \$18 and may be purchased at the UCSD Box Office from TicketMaster outlets.

The program will be an all-Beethoven program: Quartet in C minor, Opus 18, No. 4; Quartet in F. Major, Opus 135 and Quartet in E minor, Opus 59, No. 2.

The quartet's members are Peter Zazofsky and Bayla Keyes, violins; Steven Ansell, viola and Michael Reynolds, cello.

The quartet is the winner of the 1981 Naumburg Chamber Music Award and won first prize at the 1980 Evian International String Quartet Competition.

The group appears annually on most of the major chamber music series in North America, and tours extensively in Europe each season.

Founded in 1979, the quartet's members met as students at the Curtis Institute of Music in Philadelphia. The Muir String Quartet has spent residencies at Yale and Boston universities. Their first recording for EMI label, of the Frank Quintet, won the Grand Prix du Disque award.
