

Recital by Nora Post on oboe and English horn

A recital by oboe and English horn player Nora Post will be presented at the University of California, San Diego, on Thursday, December 3, at 8:30 p.m.

The concert, which is free and open to the public, will be held in the Recital Hall, Building 409, Matthews Campus.

Miss Post, a junior at John Muir College, is majoring in theoretical studies of music. She has attended the Julliard School of Music, Interlachen Arts Academy, North Carolina School of the Arts, and Northwestern University. Her previous concert appearances include Boston, Chicago, Expo '67, and the New York World Fair of 1964.

The program will include Telemann's A-minor Oboe Concerto, "Cinque Frammenti" by Donald Martino, Gunther Schuller's Sonata for Oboe and Piano, and "Casta Nora" by Ben Johnston. Performing with Miss Post will be Nancy Turetzky, flute; Bertram Turetzky, contrabass; Louise Spizizen, harpsichord; Alexina Louie, piano; and James Campbell, audio.
