Coronado Islands.

THOS CORONADOS, a group of islands 15 miles due south of Point Loma, and about 8 miles off the Mexican coast. There are two large islands and several small ones; the South Island, the largest one in the group, has an elevation of about 700 feet. The only inhabitants are birds and seals.

These Islands are reached by Steamers Virginia and Golden West, which leave the Star Boat House twice a week, Saturdays and Sundays, at 9 a. m.

Upon arriving at the Islands, after a 2½ hours' sail, with fishing on the way, excursionists can view the wonders of submarine life in comfort from our glass bottom boat. The wonderful caves and vegetation, the numberless and diversified forms of marine life, the rich variety of color and the constantly changing scene below the surface of the ocean, together form a panoramic picture never to be forgotten, and pronounced by world-wide travelers to be the most fascinating submarine view on the globe. After a two hours' stop on the South Island for lunch and shell gathering, the run is made to North, or Corpus Christi Island, the home of the birds and seals. The seal rookeries, inhabited by one of the largest herds on the coast, are alone worth the cost of the trip.

Take Car No. 9 or 10, and get off at Star Boat House, foot of Market St.

A DELIGHTFUL RIDE on the quiet waters of the Bay, passing the following points of interest: **North Island**, where the Curtis Aviation Field is located; **Roseville**; **La Playa**, mentioned in Dana's book, "Two Years Before the Mast"; **U. S. Quarantine and Coaling Station**; **Fort Rosecrans**, where a 30-minute stop is made to see the immense disappearing guns that guard the Harbor Entrance. From here the trip is continued on past Fort Pio Pico, Point Loma Lighthouse, and around the Bell Buoy.

Those who do not desire to take the Ocean Trip may remain at the Fort until the boat stops on the way back.

RETURNING, arrive in San Diego at 5:15 p. m.





FOR A PLEASANT OUTING

Take the **Point Loma Ferry** at the **Star Boat House** any morning, and spend the day at the many interesting places reached by this route :

The Curtis Aviation School on North Island, where the Aeroplanes, both the land machine and the flying boat, may be inspected and seen in flight.

Roseville, from where a short walk takes you to the Theosophical Headquarters and U. S. Wireless Station.

Fort Rosecrans, where the immense disappearing guns can be seen. From here a walk of half a mile takes you to the Bennington Monument and the Old Light House. This is the spot characterized by Charles Dudley Warner as

“One of the Finest View Points in the World.”
