

Harry A. Moore named Assistant Contracts and Grants officer

Harry A. Moore, son of Mr. and Mrs. George W. Moore, Jr., of Reserve, Kansas, has been named Assistant Contracts and Grants Officer for the University of California, San Diego.

Moore, a 1947 graduate of Hiawatha High School, has been assigned the responsibility for the administration and negotiation of federal grants for the 4,800 student UCSD campus. For the past eight years he has served as a supervisor in the school's accounting office.

UCSD is located on a 1,000 acre campus overlooking the Pacific Ocean 13 miles north of San Diego. It was designated a general campus by the University Regents in 1959 and accepted its first undergraduates in 1964. Affiliated with the campus is the UCSD School of Medicine and the world famous Scripps Institution of Oceanography.

Following graduation from Hiawatha High School, Moore attended Baker University in Baldwin City, Kansas, and then joined the U.S. Marine Corps where he served for nine and a half years. While in the Marines, Moore graduated from Oceanside Carlsbad Junior College in Oceanside, California. He is currently taking class work at San Diego State College.

Moore and his wife, Judith, have one daughter, Melanie, 13.
