I wrote to you about twelve months ago which I suppose has miscarried else you would say I am well assured I have answered it and when I sent it I look'd great deals of care to put it in all good hands & I was in hopes to have heard from you but before I wrote to you there arrived three letters from you one from your sister Elizabeth Draper another to your brother and one to my father and who are all present well in health but your dear Mother had departed this life about a year and a half ago and was in great hopes to have seen you before she dy'd however I told this untimely news I suppose you or give you some are (without excepting one) Subject to the pangs of death My Brother Michael & my Sister Ann shall desire that their love to be remembered to you My dear Father God was pleas'd to call him to his heavenly home where we in hopes to meet him at present we are at distant and Subject to all accidents and good comes in this world Dear Sir: I hope & I pray your brother give his hearty love to you and desire to hear from you if you are alive and desire to be remembered to your wife and family I have been thinking ago at West and since I am told that your sister Draper is married but I am not sure of it I am not sure of what his name is Dear Sir: If this comes to your hands (hoping you are well alive) to tell me how from you by the first opportunity of your health and welfare and if you please to send any letters to my Father direct to me I'll send or deliver them myself to him. If please any convenient friend have sent a token of kind things or articles but please by the time I shall from you please to send you some
