Hatheway - - Capt. W. Parke Judge Advocate.

The Court after being duly sworn proceeded to the Trial of
Israel Woodcock of Capt. Board's, Co^opany in Col. Bunde's Regt. bro't before
the Court & accused of assaulting & abusing an Officer the evening of the
29th Dec^r last.

The Prisoner being arraigned on the above Charge pleads guilty
The Court being cleared: adjudge the Prisoner to suffer three Weeks
Imprisonment & pay a Fine of three Pounds lawful Money to be deducted
out of his Wages & one half thereof to be paid to Sen. Sewell for the abuse
offered to him the other half to be applied according to the 52^d Article of
the Rules & Regulations of the Continental Army.
