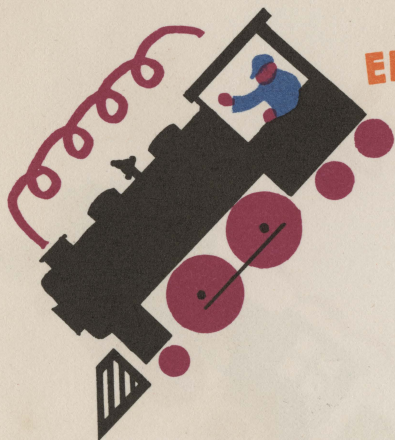


# Children's Menu

## COOK

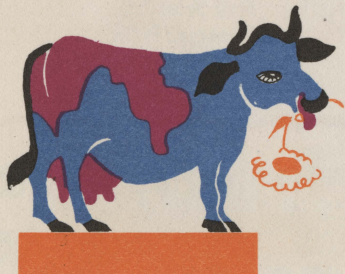
Our jolly chef is nice to know,

So he can sell his food to us.

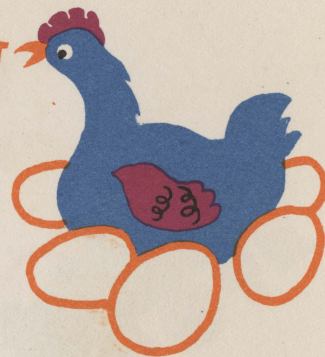


## SUSIE
