

Regents confirm action to proceed with development of general campus site at La Jolla

A committee of The Regents of the University of California has confirmed action to proceed with the development of the general campus site at La Jolla selected last May, President Clark Kerr announced in Berkeley today.

After selection of this site, the question was raised among The Regents as to whether the noise from aircraft using the Miramar Naval Air Station would interfere with educational activities of a campus at that site.

In a meeting of the Grounds and Buildings Committee of The Regents at Davis on Friday, October 23rd, The Regents considered studies made of noise from aircraft in the area. They decided that noise was not a prohibitive problem, and confirmed the action of May to develop the site. This action made it unnecessary to bring the matter up before the full Board.
