

28th annual All-University Faculty Conference of the University of California held

March 28, 1974

The 28th annual All-University Faculty Conference of the University of California was held Tuesday, March 26, through Thursday, March 28, on the Revelle College campus of the University of California, San Diego.

UC President Charles J. Hitch, statewide UC officials and approximately 100 delegates representing the nine UC campuses attended the meeting.

Purpose of the conference is to provide faculty with an opportunity to discuss critical issues regarding the university and higher education.

Theme of the 1974 session was "Applied and Public Service Research in the University of California."

Laurel E. Glass, professor anatomy at UC San Francisco, and John C. Ries, assistant director of the Institute of Government and Public Affairs at UCLA, served as co-chairpersons of the program.

This was the first year UCSD hosted the conference. The meeting site rotates between the northern and southern UC campuses.
