

Note to Editors, Dr. David Saxon visit

Dr. David Saxon, president of the University of California, will visit San Diego and the UC San Diego campus Tuesday, October 14, as part of the regional visit program he has been conducting throughout the state.

No press conference has been scheduled but there are several events which may be of interest. Only the educators' breakfast and the afternoon reception for Chancellor Atkinson are on the campus. The following schedule should help in covering Saxon's brief stay.

Tuesday, October 14

7:30 to 9 a.m. Educators' breakfast for approximately 150 high school and community college student advisors in the UC San Diego Pub. Saxon will speak for 15 to 20 minutes and conduct a Q and A session with those in attendance.

Noon to 1:30 p.m. Luncheon with La Jolla Rotary, La Valencia Hotel, La Jolla. Introduction by Chancellor Atkinson followed by a 15 minute multimedia presentation. Saxon will speak on "The Future of U.C.," with a Q and A session to follow.

4:30 to 6:30 p.m. Reception honoring Chancellor Atkinson in the East Room of the Mandeville Center for the Arts on the UC San Diego campus. Approximately 250 persons have been invited from the campus and the community to greet the new chancellor at the reception hosted by President Saxon.

Evening President Saxon departs for Los Angeles.
