UCSD TO HOLD CAREER FAIR FEB. 22 FOR IR/PS GRADUATE STUDENTS

The University of California, San Diego's Graduate School of International Relations and Pacific Studies (IR/ PS) will hold a Business & Government Career Fair Feb. 22, from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. at the Robinson Building Complex at IR/PS.

The Career Fair is expected to bring more than 20 San Diego- based as well as international companies in direct contact with IR/PS students. IR/PS currently has more than 200 graduate students who are earning a Master of Pacific International Affairs degree. IR/PS students all have concentrations in either international management, international relations or comparative public policy, as well as foreign language fluency in Spanish, Japanese, Chinese, or Korean.

Companies already participating in the Career Fair include Hewlett Packard, Solar Turbines, Anderson Consulting, and the Swiss banking firm, Bank Julius Bear.
