Senate, February 25, 1850.

“ The Select committee to whom was
“ referred the claim of Elisha O. Crosby
“ having had the same under consideration,
“ and after careful examination,
“ recommended the following Act.

“ The People of the State of
“ California represented in Senate and
“ Assembly do enact as follows:—

Section 4th.

“ That the Controller
“ of this State be and he is hereby
“ authorized and directed to issue
“ his warrant, drawn upon the
“ Treasurer of this State to and
“ payable to Elisha O. Crosby

"for the sum of Seventeen hundred
"dollars (1700), said sum to be paid
"by the Treasurer of this State out
"of any moneys belonging to the State
"in his hands not otherwise appro-
-priated.

Section 2nd

This Act shall take effect
"immediately after its passage.
