UCSD'S DEPARTMENT OF MUSIC AND FRIENDS HAVE JOINT ART SHOW

The Department of Music at the University of California, San Diego has an art exhibition on view at the East Room of the Mandeville Auditorium that shows works by its faculty, staff, and the department's support group--the UCSD Friends of Music.

The exhibition, titled "Visual Notes: An Exhibition of Two and Three Dimensional Art," will close on Feb. 22.

The show contains works of sculpture, including a 400-pound, eight-foot steel floor work; photography; architectural drawings; wood and marble carvings; paintings and an exotic aquarium complete with Siamese fighting fish.

Among the exhibitors are classical scholar and UCSD adjunct professor Marianne McDonald and Nobel laureate Roger Guillemin of the Whittier Institute.

The exhibition may be viewed prior to the UCSD Department of Music's SONOR concert at 8 p.m. Feb. 16, in the Mandeville Auditorium, and at other times.
