

Science fiction author Ray Bradbury to speak at Revelle

Science fiction author Ray Bradbury will be a guest on the campus of the University of California, San Diego on Wednesday, December 3.

Bradbury, who wrote Martian Chronicles and Fahrenheit 451, is also a well-known author to readers who do not necessarily appreciate science fiction. This may be because he deals with real problems of our time, only exaggerating them and putting them into a future time.

After visiting with students and faculty members at a luncheon and in several classes, Bradbury will give a lecture at 8:30 p.m. in the Revelle Cafeteria. The topic will be "The Creative Impulse in Apollo Year One." Informal discussions and a reception at the Beagle Hall Guest Apartment will be held afterward at 10:00 p.m.
