

## **Some 250 California community college counselors will gather for up-to-date information on services offered by University of California**

Some 250 California community college counselors will gather at the University of California, San Diego Friday, Sept. 21, for up-to-date information on admissions, financial aid and student services offered by the University of California.

The meeting, the 26th annual University of California Conference with Community College Counselors, is designed to provide current information on the issues of most importance to counselors, incoming students and the university. This year, in response to requests, the emphasis will be in the areas of admission and financial aids.

The counselors, representing mainly the southern schools in the 105-campus state community college system, will be the guests of the UC Office of Relations with Schools which serves as a link between the university and counselors of high school and community college students.

Participants in the day-long program will meet with representatives from each of the nine UC campuses as well as statewide university officials and representatives of the Army ROTC programs.

The coordinator for the conference, being held for the first time on the San Diego campus, is Sam D. Hinton, director of relations with schools for UCSD.

The meeting will begin with a general session at 9 a.m. in room 2722 of the Undergraduate Sciences Building, Revelle College. Speakers will include Dr. Paul Saltman, UCSD vice chancellor-academic affairs, and UC statewide officials Howard B. Shontz, director of relations with schools, Lyle C. Gainsley, director of admissions, and Ted D. Johnston, coordinator of financial aids.

Following the showing of "Which Campus," a new film about the University of California, the counselors will break into section meetings on admissions and financial aids for the balance of the morning. Afternoon sessions will be devoted to discussion of the individual UC campuses.

In addition to the meeting at UCSD, a second conference for community college counselors in Northern California will be held Friday, Sept. 28, at UC Santa Cruz.

The two annual meetings for counselors, formerly held only on the UC Berkeley and UCLA campuses, now rotate among all UC campuses.
