

Summer Session open to high school students

May 13, 1980

High school students who have completed their junior year are eligible to enroll in Summer Session courses at the University of California, San Diego.

Summer Session should be of interest to students who wish to try their wings in a college or university level course or to those who wish to accrue college or university credits prior to enrolling in a university or college after graduation from high school. It should be especially appealing to those students who wish to pursue a special intellectual interest.

It may also be possible to have Summer Session credits applied to high school graduation requirements. However, arrangements should be approved by the student's high school counselor in advance since UC San Diego has no control over high school graduation requirements.

Exceptional students who have not completed the junior year of high school may also be admitted to Summer Session classes by special petition to Mr. Thomas Hull, director of Summer Session. Admission will be based primarily on the student's academic record and a recommendation from one of his or her teachers or counselors.
