

Control Data Corporation Model 1604 to arrive on campus March 7

A new computer which is one of the largest and most flexible to be installed on any university campus in the nation has been shipped from Minneapolis and is due to arrive at the University of California, San Diego on Tuesday, March 7.

The Computer, Control Data Corporation Model 1604, will be used in problems in physics, chemistry, oceanography and biology. It was purchased with funds provided the San Diego Campus by the Atomic Energy Commission.

It should be in operation by March 15, according to Clay L. Perry, mathematician who heads the campus Computation Facility.

The Computer is being shipped by van.
