

George's Island Oct 24th 1861

Dear Sisters

I wrote you the other day
but as the sloop stop here bound
to Guaymas I thought I would send
you a few lines I am in good health
except from wishes to be remembered to
you all I shall stop here some 3 months
longer and then to some other Island
or some other Employment, it is hard
to say what I shall go at next when
I get out of Employment here but
I hope I shall find some thing to
do more profitable than this small
wages but it is better than nothing,
Mr Bishop from Westhampton
has been here on the Island with me
he leaves to day for San Francisco
he thinks of going home when he arrives
there he will either mail this letter
at San Francisco or will deliver it to you
as he may go to San Pedro nothing
has transpired since I wrote you last
my love to Sister Charlot & Eliza and all
the rest your affectionate Brother
