UCSD APPOINTS SENIOR DIRECTOR OF UNIVERSITY PROJECTS

Edgar M. Gillenwaters of Carlsbad, a specialist in Southern California economics and growth, has been appointed senior director of University Projects at the University of California, San Diego.

Gillenwaters served as CEO and president of the Walnut Land Company of Los Angeles the past 10 years. Prior to that he was director of private banking, Bank of America; corporate vice president of national accounts, Coldwell Banker Commercial Real Estate Co., and director, California Department of Commerce.

During the Reagan administration in California he served as Governor's liaison with the White House, U.S. Congress, federal agencies and foreign embassies. Prior to that he was administrative assistant to U.S. Congressman Bob Wilson, R., San Diego.

Gillenwaters also served as vice president and director of the National Athletic Institute.

Among his past volunteer activities are service as vice chair of the University of Southern California campaign to build a health science campus; vice chair of the California Economic Development Commission; co-chair of the California Space Shuttle Committee and board member, Thomas Jefferson Research Institute.

He currently serves as a board member of the Hubbs-Sea World Research Institute and is a member of UCSD's Scripps Institution of Oceanography Director's Circle, the Greater San Diego Chamber of Commerce and the Mingei Museum of World Folk Art.
