AFORE PATROL No. 1 of 1969/1970

attached please find in triplicate typed and unsigned copies of Mr. Patrol Officer Genera's report on the above-mentioned patrol. This presentation is occasioned because Mr. Genera has not followed instructions in the preparation of patrol reports. A duplicopy of his report was received here and the report was addressed to Senior Local Government Officer at Popondetta. Patrol report covers have also been prepared by this office.

- The patrol was broken and was mounted to assist with the Afore L.G.Council's taxpayers' meetings. Three meetings were held and this appeared adequately to cover the council area two in the Managalase Census Division and one in the Musa. The patrol was completed on 1st February, 1970, and the report dated 17th April, 1970 was received on 27th April, 1970.
- 3. Points arising out of the body of the report ares
- (a) There is a great difference in economic production between the two Census Divisions. The Managalase, population 5800 approx., is expected to produce 100 tens of arabica coffee in the coming year. The Musa has virtually no economic production. This accounts for the desire of the Musa to retain old tax rates.
- (b) It appears that tax rates were the sole subject discussed at the meetings. Not very much else was reported. It is hard to envisage that the subject was talked about all day, with a break for lunch see Patrol Diary for 10th, 17th and 29th January, 1970.
- (c) No Situation Report was included.

It is disappointing that an officer of over two years' field experience is not familiar with requirements of a patrol report
