





In collaboration with Student Against Mass Incarceration, join us for a workshop on the radical possibilities of stencil making.

SDSU Body Pride Project

We are recruiting participants for our body acceptance program to investigate different approaches to improve body image among adult sexual minority men (i.e., men who identify as gay, bisexual, or sexually attracted to men).

Following a brief phone screener, you will also be asked to complete an initial assessment in the lab to determine eligibility. Eligible participants will then be invited to complete one of two 2-session group-based body image acceptance programs, which have shown to be effective in improving body image. Following the group sessions, you will be asked to



complete further follow-up assessments, at 1-2 weeks, and at 6, 12, 18 and 24 months.

You will be reimbursed with a \$25 Amazon gift card for each completed assessment, and will receive an additional \$25 Amazon gift card if you complete all assessments.


