### WHO MAY QUALIFY?

- Identify as transgender or non-binary
- 18 years or older
- HIV-negative
- You can already be on PrEP
- You don't have to currently be sexually active

### WHAT DOES THE STUDY INVOLVE?

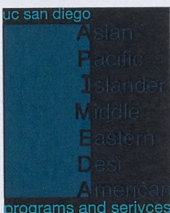
