Queer and Asian Collective

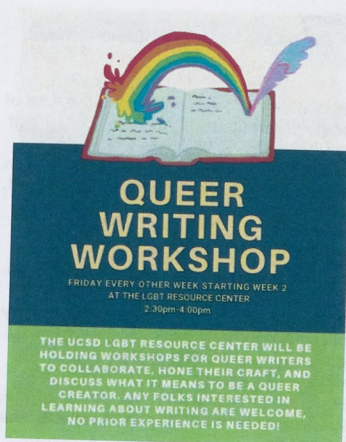

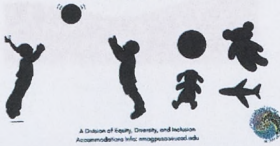

Ecological systems theory scholars in the field of Psychology correctly detected a problem: that of dehumanization occurring in the world (Bronfenbrenner: Making Human Beings Human, 2004). However, as Sylvia Wynter has explained, a fundamental error is being made when modern/colonial capitalist Man is assumed to represent the human and the color line is ignored. This discussion addresses that problem directly by elaborating an explicitly critical framework that accounts for capitalism's history of colonialism in which ecological perspectives can be nested. Further, we explore the theoretical and practical implications of a deepened conceptualization of macrosystemic and chronosystemic contributors to development for black youth.



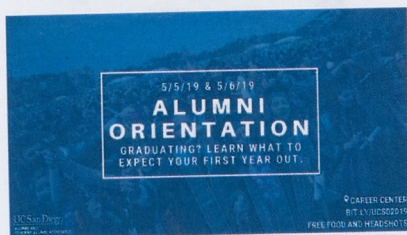


the gate. *Put Your House in Order* is equal parts romantic comedy and old-school thriller. This world premiere play explores new beginnings at the end of the world."

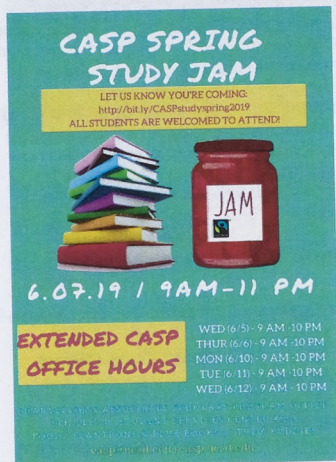

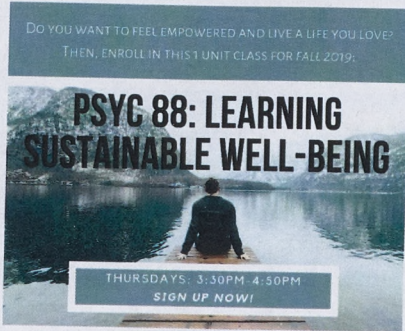

UC San Diego PrEP Research Study

UC San Diego has a research study that provides PrEP at no cost. PrEP is pre-exposure prophylaxis, a daily pill that helps prevent HIV.

WHO MAY QUALIFY?

- Identify as transgender or non-binary
- 18 years or older
- HIV-negative
- You can already be on PrEP
- You don't have to currently be sexually active

WHAT DOES THE STUDY INVOLVE?

- Six visits over a one year period
- HIV/STI testing and safety labs at no cost
- Daily text reminder to help take PrEP everyday
- Answer surveys about your sexual health
