**UCSD'S LESBIAN, GAY AND BISEXUAL STUDENT ORGANIZATION TO HOLD RALLY PROTESTING VIOLENCE AND HARASSMENT OF HOMOSEXUALS MAY 22**

The University of California, San Diego's Lesbian, Gay and Bisexual Association (LGBA) will hold a rally on UCSD's gym steps at noon tomorrow (May 22) to protest several threatening phone calls as well as to promote awareness of violence aimed at homosexuals on campus.

The two hour protest will feature student, faculty and staff speakers.

LGBA's office received eight threatening phone calls, including one bomb threat, on May 10, 1991, in response to announcement of the organization's first annual semi-formal May 11. The event, billed as the high school prom many gays never had, was held without incident at UCSD's Price Center Ballroom.
