CORRECTION OF RAFAEL DRUIAN CONCERT NEWS RELEASE DATED JUNE 23, 1972

Rafael Druian, concertmaster of the New York Philharmonic, will conduct a chamber concert at 3 a.m. (instead of 2 p.m.) Friday, July 7, in Sherwood Hall, 700 Prospect, La Jolla.

All performers in the concert have participated in a special three-week Chamber Music Institute directed by Druian and under the sponsorship of the University of California, San Diego. The concert is free and open to the public.

The program will include Schubert's "Symphony No. 5 in B Flat," Carter's "Elegy for Strings," Mozart's "Violin# Concerto No. 5 in A, to and Bach's "Violin Concerto in E Major."
