

Osborne and Wyman placed on suspension

William K. Osborne was hired as a Senior Oiler for the Argo in Seattle on May 9, 1960. His address at that time was Seattle. Dale E. Wyman was hired as an Able-bodied Seaman on June 2, 1960, at Seattle. His address at that time was Seattle. Both men were among the crew that sailed the Argo from Seattle to San Diego, arriving here last Thursday, June 9. They have since been living aboard the ship.

The men of The University's research fleet are civilians. Each of them is required to obtain clearance from the U. S. government to handle classified information. Obtaining these clearances takes several months, as a thorough search of the man's background is required. Because they had been working for us only a few weeks, Osborne and Wyman do not have clearances and they have had no access to classified information.

Both have been placed on suspension pending disposition of the present charges.
