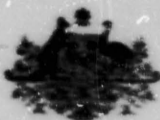

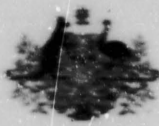

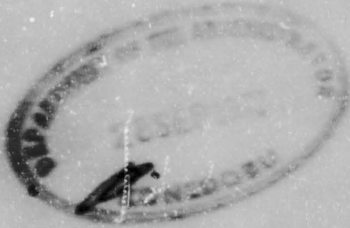

INTRODUCTION

This patrol was one of three mounted for the express purpose of conducting the fifth general elections for the Lagaip Local Government Council. Whilst in the field the patrol carried out some other tasks as requested by the Assistant District Commissioner.

In this report no details will be given on the Council Elections, as they have been already reported on in detail, in the Election report forwarded to the District Local Government Officer.

MOUNT HAGEN SHOW

The 2nd August 1973 was the date advertised for the Mount Hagen Show. During the Show discussions at each resthouse, interest appeared good and many volunteered to go down to Mt. Hagen and help out with the preparations.

Archery contests were held at each resthouse to determine from which group the 3 archers for the Show would be chosen.

The following men are possible candidates:

RAMEN TSU of PIAGAIN
IOMIS of PAPAYUK
AGU KIPINBI of PONGERAS
POTO BAIPARA of YOGANDA

There is no shortage of athletes for the Show and perhaps it would be an idea to call them into the station to pick the cream through elimination heats.

PRECAUTIONS AGAINST FUTURE FROSTS

Extensive inquiries were made at each resthouse to evaluate the precautions taken by the people to ensure that they may still subsist without Government aid should another frost arise.

With the coming of the dry season, no precautions at all have been made. The people at each resthouse adamantly maintain that if their gardens were again damaged by frost the Government should feed them. They informed the writer that there is still some rice remaining from the last frost relief together with some funds and that this should be kept to feed them should there be another severe frost. They claim that if the Government won't help them they will starve.

DISCUSSION AGAINST FUTURE FROSTS (cont.)

Suggestions that they should cover their gardens by night with sunai were met with scorn and denials that this would stop frost destruction of plants. The idea of plastic sheeting was met with more enthusiasm, however, they also expected it as a gift. They were informed that if they wanted plastic sheeting they would be required to pay for it.

Since these discussions some people from Yagenda have approached the Manager of the Vocational Centre and enquired about plastic sheeting.


It is believed that the majority of the people will not bother to take precautions or at least to because they firmly believe that the Government will certainly help them with food again should there be another severe frost. Informing them otherwise makes little impression on them.
