ACCOMMODATIONS

MANY additional tent-houses have been added to the resort; yet with the increased facilities, reservations should be arranged as far in advance of arrival as possible. Tent houses, palm cottages and rooms in the Arcade Hotel are comfortably furnished. Tent houses have beds or cots, chairs, table, wash stand, mirror, linen and laundry service for same, gas plate, electric light and running water near each tent. Palm cottages are more elaborately furnished and with most of the usual comforts of modern residences.

Telephone, telegraph and post office, information bureau, reading and writing room, women's club room, restaurant, ice cream parlor, band pavilion and main office of resort are located in the center of Tent City and on the car line.

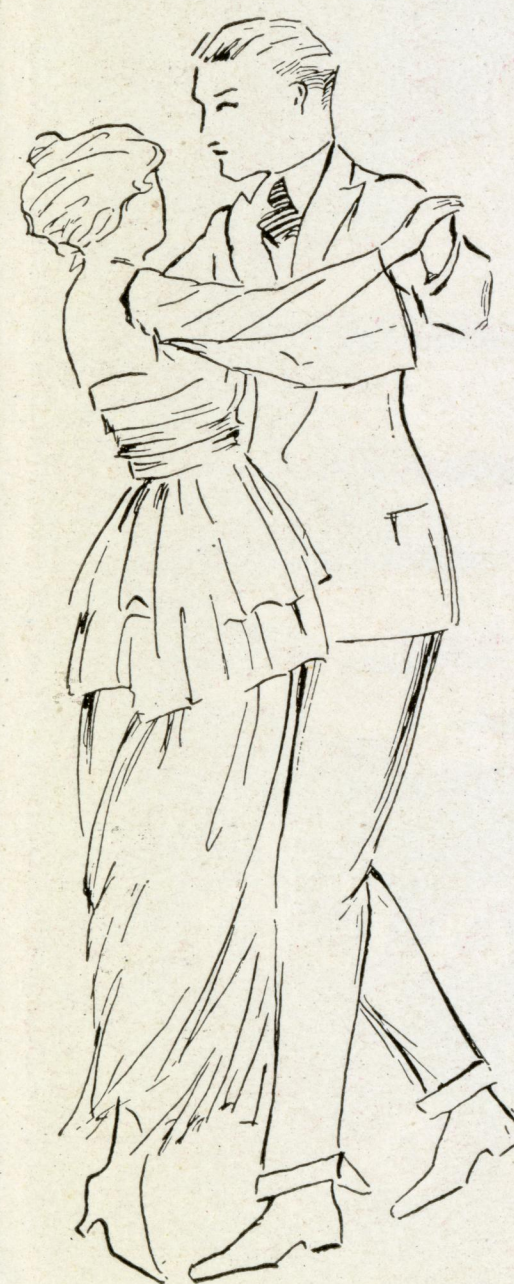
Summer Excursion Rates are Effective May 13th

And low round trip tickets will be on sale until September 30th. They apply from all points in California, Arizona and New Mexico to San Diego via the El Paso and South Western, Southern Pacific, San Diego and Arizona, Santa Fe and Salt Lake Lines. Excursion rates from El Paso and eastern points to San Diego are also effective during Summer months.

Coronado Tent City is reached by train, steamship or automobile via San Diego, which is the terminal of the Santa Fe and San Diego and Arizona Railways and the Pacific Steamship Co. The resort is within thirty minutes' ride by street car, automobile and ferry of the Union Depot, Municipal Pier, Theatre and Shopping District of San Diego. The ferry service between Coronado and San Diego has been greatly improved since the new and larger ferry steamer "Morena" was added to the fleet operating on this run. The "Morena" has a capacity of from forty to forty-five machines

on its main deck and ample accommodations for 800 passengers on the upper deck. Street cars make direct connection with ferries on the San Diego and Coronado sides. Cars on route number 9 operate between the San Diego ferry station and Fifth and Broadway, San Diego, providing direct connection with lines to all parts of the city suburbs and other beaches. Cars on the Coronado side during Tent City season operate between ferry station and center of resort.

Sports and Amusements

Important rowing and swimming meets, championship events, are scheduled each season on the smooth waters of Glorietta Bay at Tent City under the auspices of the San Diego Rowing Club. Yacht regattas are of frequent occurrence and full notice in the daily press is published in advance of all feature competitions.

Tent City has the finest open-air swimming facilities in America, with large and small floats, spring boards, diving tower, showers and a commodious bath house. There is also an open-air salt water pool for women and children. Surf bathing is also available. Deep sea fishing is enjoyed daily. Excellent catches of yellowtail, barracuda, sea bass and other species are assured when visiting the fishing grounds off Coronado in specially equipped launches of the Coronado Boat House.

Canoes, row boats and sail boats may be rented at moderate charges by the hour or day. Aquaplaning is a popular amusement, and the speedy launch "Glorietta" may be chartered for this strenuous sport.

Open-air concerts afternoon and evening begin June 11th and there is dancing to be enjoyed at the Tent City Dance Pavilion to the steppy jazz of the Tent City Orchestra. Bowling, Pool, Skee Ball and numerous other forms of amusement for old and young, including the ever popular Merry-go-round, are provided for the pleasure of guests. Moonlight launch rides, beach parties, informal card parties and special entertainment attractions are features which add so much to the continual enjoyment of Tent City's Summer population.

Motoring is indulged in under ideal conditions. All streets in Coronado are paved, and smooth highways lead to mountains, beaches and quaint Old Mexico. Choose your favorite recreation at Tent City.
