COMPLAINT:

[REDACTED] was being processed for release from CCA at the INS offices on Front Street in Downtown San Diego on the above date and time. Agent [REDACTED] began to instruct everyone that they were not to leave the country for any reason. [REDACTED] asked if he could visit in Mexico because he was an LPR. [REDACTED] yelled at [REDACTED] "you are not a citizen, and you never will be." He also told [REDACTED] "Smart ass, we'll keep you. We don't have to let you out today." Another agent offered to assist [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] told agent [REDACTED] that there was no reason to yell at him, that he was just asking him a question. [REDACTED] told agent [REDACTED] he would talk to him later. Agent [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] he would also be talking to him later. After agent [REDACTED] finished with the other inmates, he told [REDACTED] "lets go outside" and grabbed [REDACTED] by the shirt. [REDACTED] grabbed agent [REDACTED] wrist. Other agents came over and separated them.

Agent [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] to follow him outside. As they were walking out to the front, [REDACTED] yelled at [REDACTED] "don't ever walk behind me." [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] he was only doing what he told him. When they reached the outside, [REDACTED] challenged [REDACTED] to a fight. He called [REDACTED] a "pussy", "punk" and a "coward." Agent [REDACTED] also reached for his gun. Then he pulled it out and handed it to another agent to hold. Eventually, [REDACTED] and the other agents went inside.

Notice to Respondent

Warning: Any statement you make may be used against you in removal proceedings.

Alien Registration: This copy of the Notice to Appear served upon you is evidence of your alien registration while you are under removal proceedings. You are required to carry it with you at all times.

Representation: If you so choose, you may be represented in this proceeding, at no expense to the Government, by an attorney or other individual authorized and qualified to represent persons before the Executive Office for Immigration Review, pursuant to 8 CFR 3.16. Unless you so request, no hearing will be scheduled earlier than ten days from the date of this notice, to allow you sufficient time to secure counsel. A list of qualified attorneys and organizations who may be available to represent you at no cost will be provided with this Notice.

Conduct of the hearing: At the time of your hearing, you should bring with you any affidavits or other documents which you desire to have considered in connection with your case. If any document is in a foreign language, you must bring the original and a certified English translation of the document. If you wish to have the testimony of any witnesses considered, you should arrange to have such witnesses present at the hearing.


At your hearing you will be given the opportunity to admit or deny any or all of the allegations in the Notice to Appear and that you are inadmissible or deportable on the charges contained in the Notice to Appear. You will have an opportunity to present evidence on your own behalf, to examine any evidence presented by the Government, to object, on proper legal grounds, to the receipt of evidence and to cross examine any witnesses presented by the Government.

You will be advised by the immigration judge before whom you appear, of any relief from removal for which you may appear eligible including the privilege of departing voluntarily. You will be given a reasonable opportunity to make any such application to the immigration judge.


Failure to appear: You are required to provide the INS, in writing, with your full mailing address and telephone number. You must notify the Immigration Court immediately by using Form EOIR-33 whenever you change your address or telephone number during the course of this proceeding. You will be provided with a copy of this form. Notices of hearing will be mailed to this address. If you do not submit Form EOIR-33 and do not otherwise provide an address at which you may be reached during proceedings, then the Government shall not be required to provide you with written notice of your hearing. If you fail to attend the hearing at the time and place designated on this notice, or any date and time later directed by the Immigration Court, a removal order may be made by the immigration judge in your absence, and you may be arrested and detained by the INS.

Request for Prompt Hearing

To expedite a determination in my case, I request an immediate hearing. I waive my right to have a 10-day period prior to appearing before an immigration judge.
