WINE AUCTION/BENEFIT FOR UCSD CANCER CENTER PLANNED

Items such as a double magnum of Ch. Mouton-Rothschild 1982, awarded 100 points as the "perfect wine," and an 11-day cruise along the French seacoast, including a day in the Bordeaux wine region, are among those to be auctioned off Oct. 11 at a benefit sponsored by the UCSD Cancer Center Foundation.

Titled "Grape Expectations--A Vintage Wine Auction," the event will be held at the Rancho Santa Fe estate of Mr. and Mrs. Ben Kelts. Serving as co-chairs are Carrie O'Brien and Sherri Kelts.

In addition to some 100 cases of wine from the prized Bruce Brown collection to be offered at both silent and live auctions, additional items include a weekend retreat in the Portola Valley, an Hawaiian getaway to the Mauna Kea Beach Hotel, a gourmet dinner for eight prepared by Anne Otterson and Lois Stanton, and the 11-day European cruise aboard the Seabourn.

The event will begin with a hosted champagne bar and silent auction from 5 to 7 p.m., followed by a sit-down dinner. Proceeds are designated for UCSD Cancer Center research projects.
