UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA REGENTS TO TARE PART IN UCSD'S ASSOCIATED STUDENTS' EDUCATION FORUM

A panel of sixteen experts in the field of education, including five members of the University of California Board of Regents, will take part in the UCSD Associated Student (AS) Education Forum to be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday, May 31, in the UCSD Price Center Ballroom.

The two-hour event will be a question-and-answer session to provide students with answers to issues they might have concerning higher education. Each student will be given two minutes to ask their question; panelists will have two minutes in which to reply.

Opening remarks will be made by UCSD student Naomi Falk, AS Education Forum event coordinator, followed by brief presentations by the panelists. UCSD Vice Chancellor of Student Affairs Joseph Watson will moderate. The free event is expected to draw up to 500 UCSD students, staff, faculty and members of the community.

Panel members include UC Regents Roy T. Brophy; Clair W. Burgener; S. Sue Johnson; Meredith Khachigian; and Darby Morrisroe. Also participating will be California Assembly Member Gwen Moore; UCSD Associate Chancellor Tracy Strong; UCSD Professor of Literature and Academic Senate Chair Stephen Cox; Professor of History Steven Hahn; UC Student Affairs President Don Harjo Daves, of UC Santa Barbara; and UC Student Affairs Executive Director Glen Magpantay of Sacramento.
