Our place has greatly increased since you saw it, a census taken of New Town by the minister foots up 400 souls, men, women and children, six of these being children, yet it seems that Doctors are coming faster than the people.

Lots have greatly increased in price, they are worth anywhere within half a mile of the ~~Baracks~~ Officers Quarters when Capt Winder was living, from \$50⁰⁰ to \$200⁰⁰ and some have been sold at \$300⁰⁰.

We hope they will continue to increase but

many doubt it.

The National Ranch was sold for \$30000 a few months ago (six miles below New Town) and the Rajon 12 miles East of San Diego has been sold for \$48000 - and other ranches in the same proportion.

I would like to have you come down & locate here - (and would advise you to come and see for yourself anyway) and think no doubt you could work up a practice as the place grows, but it is doubtful if you could make expenses for awhile.

Hoffman is not liked here, McHenry is a

drunkard, and the others
are new men & don't seek
practice.
