

We completed a verbal arrangement with Robinson regarding the matter, and upon that arrangement wired you, to be sure that Robinson's claim was true; when I learned for the first time that the construction bids were already opened, and that the bonds advertised would be cancelled.

Had the information reaching us been other than it was, we should have been at San Deigo on the 27th ult., prepared to bid. In fact, our H. H. Burrell, was already on the way, and was wired to stor at Tulare.

I have no one to blame in the matter except myself for accepting a telegram over a telephone wire; but I am afraid that your bicks; anxiety to make a show of starting construction, by opening the bids, is likely to prove a boomerang; for, I question very much whether any sale of your bonds can be made except through a contract, and that upon a completed system.

There is nothing now for us to do except wait develop-In the meantime will you kindly have your Secretary send ments. us a record of the bids which were opened on the 27th ult. then determine whether it will be worth while for us to pursue the matter any further or not; and, until we receive this record, and hear from you, we will assume it unnecessary to answer the questions written us by Mr. Mulford, one of the Trustees.
