TRAFFIC REGULATIONS AND GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. ANIMALS AND BIRDS—Will not be carried.
2. BAGGAGE—California Aerial Transport, Limited, cannot guarantee to carry any set amount of baggage. They will as far as possible, conforming wifth the Department of Commerce regulations depending upon the load of the plane and the measurements of the baggage, carry twenty-five pounds in weight per person. The company assumes no imbility for loss or damage to baggage and/or personal property exceeding \$25.00 in value unless same be declared and forwarded under separate contract.

EXCESS BAGGAGE—Whenever possible the California Aerial Transport, Limited, will carry baggage in excess of twenty-five pounds per person at the tariff rate of one-half of one per cent of the passenger fare per pound. A minimum charge of twenty-five cents will be collected. Charges will be collected at the initial airport.

WEIGHT AND MEASUREMENT OF BAGGAGE—California Aerial Transport, Limited, has the right to restrict the amount and size of buggage to be handled by airplane and at no time will carry more than fifty pounds per person in any one piece of baggage.

3. CANCELLATIONS—California Aerial Transport, Limited, reserves the right to cancel without advance notice any scheduled trip or reservation on account of adverse weather conditions, or other causes and for so doing shall be under no obligation to ticket holders except to refund through regular channels the price paid per ticket.

REFUND—Space may be cancelled two hours prior to the departure of the plane, and refund will be made on unused portion of ticket at original office or through accounting department of the California Aerial Transport, Limited, Should space be cancelled less than two hours prior to the departure of schedule, refund may be made only in the event that space is resold.

4. CHILDREN'S FARES—Infants under two years of age, when carried in the arms of parent or guardian, will be carried free of charge, All children under ten years of age occupying a seat will be charged one-half fare.

5. FARES—Fares quoted in this tariff apply from Airport to Airport at points indicated. We reserve the right to refuse passage to anyone.

RESERVATIONS—May be made at any the ticket omean, Hotel Travel 6. RESERVATIONS—May be made at any of the ticket offices listed herein, with any authorized Travel Bureau, Hotel Travel desks and any Postal Telegraph Office. All seats will be reserved on California Aerial Transport, Limited, planes. No positive reservation will be made except upon purchase of ticket and space must be assigned before agent issues same. Return portions of round-trip tickets will not be honored unless validated two hours prior to departure of schedule on return trip.
7. ROUND-TRIP FARES—Ten per cent reduction will be allowed on all round-trip tickets. Ninety days' return limit will be permitted on all round-trip tickets. Ten days stop-over will be allowed at intermediate points. Only one stop-over each way will be allowed.

8. DELAYS—The hours of arrival at destination and time consumed on specified trips are not guaranteed by California Aerial Transport, Limited, masmuch as the flight of airplanes is subject to delays from weather conditions and other causes wholly beyond our control. All tickets are sold with the understanding that the company assumes no responsibility for the failure of its airplanes to arrive at any destination as scheduled or for the failure of any passenger to make connection at destination with any connecting carrier or airlines.

9. CHARTER SERVICE—Charter service for special parties may be obtained at standard reduced rates when equipment is available.

10. EXPRESS SERVICE—Fast, frequent, air express service on all flight schedules at low rutes is maintained.
