CHANGE OF PROGRAM RE: PRO ARTE QUARTET TO PERFORM APRIL 26 AT UCSD

The Pro Arte Quartet, who will perform at 8 p.m. April 26 in Mandeville Auditorium at the University of California, San Diego, have altered their originally planned program.

The quartet will perform Joseph Haydn: String Quartet in Eb Major, Opus 64, No. 6 (1790); Germaine Tailieferre: String Quartet (1919); Karol Szymanowski: String Quartet No. 2, Opus 56 (1927), and Franz Schubert: String Quartet in G Major, D. 887 (1826).

Quartet members are David Perry, violin; Suzanne Beia, violin; Sally Chisholm, viola, and Parry Karp, cello. They are artists-in-residence at the University of Wisconsin at Madison, where they perform concerts, participate in radio broadcasts and contribute to music education. The ensemble also performs on national and international tours.
